

FSC/PEFC Statement

Since 2001 Team 7 has been fully focused on the problems of FSC. One of the main principles of the FSC/PEFC-certificate which we hold is the specific aim of securing sustainable forestry.

TEAM 7 guarantees, to the best of its knowledge that the raw materials we use come from sustainable forests. Our subsuppliers are contractually obligated to ensure that logging is carried out according to the applicable national forestry laws. These laws contain the following stipulations:

Forest care and use has to be carried out in a way such that the biological variety, productivity, regeneration ability, vitality and potential should be preserved permanently.

As a result forests should fulfil, now and in future, ecological, economical and societal functions at a local, national and global level, without damaging other eco systems.

Furthermore forest management has to fulfil these following criteria, as stipulated by the Ministerial Conference on the Protection of Forests in Europe of 1993 in Helsinki:

1. The Maintenance and appropriate enhancement of forest resources and their contribution to global carbon cycles
2. Maintenance of the health and vitality of the forest ecosystem
3. The Maintenance and encouragement of the productive functions of forests (both wood and non-wood)
4. Maintenance, conservation and appropriate enhancement of biological diversity in forest ecosystems
5. Maintenance and appropriate enhancement of protective functions in forest management (notably soil and water)
6. Maintenance of other socioeconomic and cultural functions and conditions

We have set ourselves the target, to only use wood from sustainable forestry sources, which means that the forest needs to be clearly regulated and controlled by the legislation of the particular country.

For this reason we do not use tropical timber!

TEAM 7 is extremely conscious of its responsibility for both man and nature!
